Baglio del Sole's winery is located four miles from the sea between Caltagirone and Piazza Armerina. Feudi del Pisciotto is another one of Paolo Panerai's ventures in the wine world: the Italian media magnate is behind other successful brands such as Castellare di Castellina and Rocca di Frassinello in Tuscany.

### TASTING NOTES

Light straw yellow color. Intense nose with pleasing and clean apple aromas. A wine with a good body and agreeable crispness. Persistent fruity finish.

### FOOD PAIRING

Ideal with fish-based dishes (pasta, risotto, whole fish), appetizers or even on its own as an aperitif.
