

## NERO D'AVOLA TERRE SICILIANE IGT

### WINE DESCRIPTION

The brand Baglio del Sole is produced by Feudi del Pisciotto, a winery located four miles from the sea between Caltagirone and Piazza Armerina. Feudi del Pisciotto is another one of Paolo Panerai's ventures in the wine world: the Italian media magnate is behind other successful brands such as Castellare di Castellina and Rocca di Frassinello in Tuscany.

### TASTING NOTES

Ruby red color with purple shades. On the nose it has typical aromas of the varietal, such as black cherry, blackberry and plum. The wine has smooth tannins and nice red fruit flavors on the palate.

Ideal with tomato sauce pasta, mushrooms and mature cheeses.
