## DAVOLAROSA BRUT ROSÉ TERRE SICILIANE IGP

### WINE DESCRIPTION

Davolarosa is a sparkling Rosé with a Sicilian character, made from the best Nero d'Avola grapes from Feudi del Pisciotto vineyards. The wine is characterized by a fine and persistent perlage, a fresh and intense bouquet, great flavors and drinkability. The name is a contraction of Davola (from Nero d'Avola) and Rosa ("pink" in Italian).

### TASTING NOTES

Brilliant coral pink color with a fine and persistente perlage. The nose is intense and delicate with seducing notes of roses and citrus fruits. The palate is harmonic, fruity and savory, with a fresh and long finish.

### FOOD PAIRING

The freshness and the incredible persistence make it a perfect combination for every meal, in particular with fish.
