## WINE DESCRIPTION

Giovanni Rosso owns the iconic Vignarionda cru Parcel Number 251P, of map Foglio number 8, in the commune of Serralunga d'Alba, which has been legendary for years and is today considered the "Romanée-Conti of Barolo." The name honors Ester Canale, granddaughter of Tommaso Canale, the original owner of the Vigna Rionda cru, which he acquired in 1934. In 2010 he passed away without a will and Vigna Rionda was split between six surviving relatives. Ester Canale, Davide Rosso's mother, was one of them. This wine is produced from the new Nebbiolo vines of Vigna Rionda planted in 2011.

## TASTING NOTES

Intense ruby red color. Very elegant bouquet with aromas of rose, blackberry, wild strawberries, peach and sweet spices. The taste is rich and soft, with fresh fruit flavors, gentle tannins and a long mineral finish.

Ideal with cod or other fish, stuffed duck, or spicy escargot.
